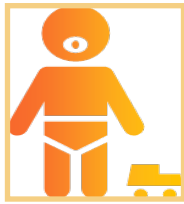

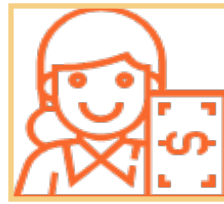

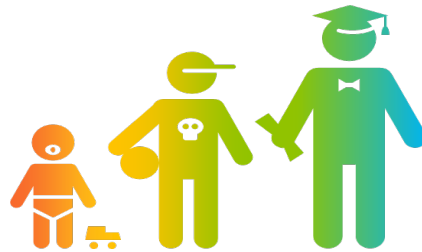

In 2022, Hopkins House helped increase the Potential Overall Earnings Power of teens and young adults enrolled in our Early Childhood Learning Institute

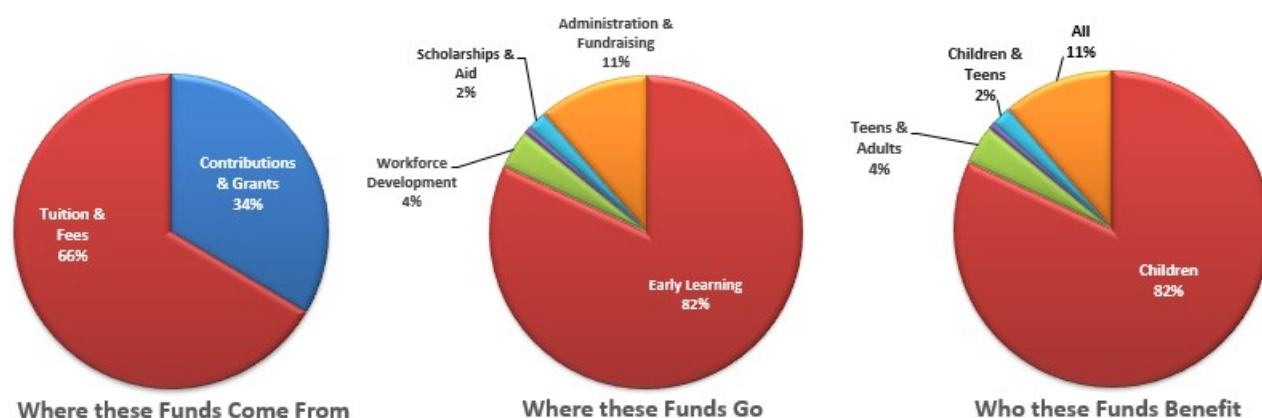
